CULGOORA MORNING REPORT 26/2100-2400Z MAR 79
GOOD OBSERVING CONDITIONS, ONLY MINOR ACTIVITY OBSERVED. RGN 1638,
NOW CROSSING THE WEST LIMB AT N07, IS PRODUCING MANY LIMB
SURGES. NONE OF THE SURGES ARE VERY STRONG BUT SINCE PATROL BEGAN
AT 2100Z, THE SURGES HAVE BEEN NEARLY CONTINUOUS. WEAK TYPE 3 RF
BURSTS RECORDED AT 26/2253Z EMANATED FROM RGN 1638.
THE NEW RGN AT E80S26 CONTAINS A MEDIUM SIZED D SPOT GROUP WITH A
LARGE LEADER SPOT. BRIGHT PLAGE IS IN THE RGN AND EXTENDS TO THE
EAST OF THE RGNS SPOT GROUP. SLOW GROWTH IS OCCURRING IN RGN 1647
(W16S30) AND THE AREA'S PLAGE IS BRIGHTER THAN IT WAS YESTERDAY.
OTHER RGNS ARE STABLE. FLEURES EW SCANS INDICATE IMP 1 CORONAL
HOLE AT W0.6QR MAR27 DEMA
