SOME SUB FLARE ACTIVITY (SEE CODES). SEVEN SPOT GROUPS  
CLEARLY VISIBLE ON THE DISK. PARALLEL RIBBON FLARE  
AT N25W05. NEW REGION (N15E80) LOOKS LIKE AN H-TYPE SPOT GROUP,  
BUT COULD HAVE TRAILER SPOTS DUE TO THE PLAGE AREA EAST OF  
THIS SPOT. SOME MINOR SURGING SE OF THIS SPOT.  
PLAGE OF MODERATE INTENSITY. REGION 1759 (N18W32) SPOT 3  
DEGREES OF LONGITUDE EAST OF LEADER SPOT HAS GROWN SLIGHTLY  
IN SPOT AREA, OTHERWISE SPOT REGION LOOKS STABLE AND UNCHANGED.  
PLAGE DULL. ALL OTHER REGIONS QUIET, STABLE, AND UNIMPRESSIVE.  
RF QUIET EXCEPT FOR A WEAK TYPE ONE NOISE STORM DEMA
