INTENSITY. REGION 1797 (S16E38) LOOKS LIKE IT HAS STABILIZED
IN SPOT AND PENUMBRAL GROWTH, WHILE REGION 1796 (N17E28) IS
STILL INCREASING IN SPOT NUMBER, SPOT AND PENUMBRAL GROWTH,
AND MAGNETIC COMPLEXITY. ALL OTHER REGIONS QUIET, STABLE, OR
UNIMPRESSIVE. AT METER WAVELENGTHS A TYPE ONE NOISE STORM
OCCUPIES THE RF. SEE CODES. DEMA
