(E70S27) ARE BOTH SMALL REGIONS CONTAINING D-TYPE SPOT GROUPS.
THEY ARE QUIETER TODAY. REGION 1840 (W18N18) IS DORMANT. A
WEAK METRE WAVE TYPE 1 STORM IS IN PROGRESS AT SEVERAL LOCATIONS.
A MODERATE TYPE 3 BURST WAS OBSERVED AT 2317Z FROM ABOVE THE
NORTH-EAST QUADRANT. DEMA
